Dr. Raigrodski is a Professor at the Department of Restorative Dentistry and an Adjunct Professor at the Department of Materials Sciences and Engineering at the University of Washington. He is a member of the editorial review boards of the Journal of Esthetic and Restorative Dentistry, the Journal of Prosthodontics, the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry, and the American Journal of Esthetic Dentistry. Dr. Raigrodski is a graduate of the Hebrew University in Jerusalem Israel. He received his certificate in Prosthodontics at Louisiana State University School of Dentistry, where he also completed a fellowship in implants and esthetics, and an MS degree.
